Sustainability Facility Professional (SFP®) Certification Preparation Course!

SFP® is a specialty certification offered by the International Facility Management Association (IFMA™). Focus is on designing and implementing sustainable facility management best practices that affect the triple bottom line: social, environmental and financial benefits for organizations, both large and small.

VOB 057 Sustainability Facility Professional®

This course is ideal for current facility managers who wish to adopt sustainability practices, facility related vendors, designers, architects, etc. The SFP® certification is intended for facilities management professionals who want to play a key leadership role in bringing sustainability best practices to their organizations. Additionally, this course qualifies for 70 LEED certification maintenance hours. It is highly recommended that students possess a foundation of professional facility management knowledge and experience.

Each two day session focuses on one of three key areas:

- **Strategy and Alignment for Sustainable Facility Management**
- **Managing Sustainable Facilities**
- **Operating Sustainable Facilities**

At the completion of each two-day section, students are tested. Upon successful completion of all sessions and tests, students are eligible to apply for the SFP certificate.

Course Cost: \$2,525 - register for CRN# 40262

Cost includes all text books and three certification tests. Does not include SFP® application fee.

Additional costs apply for non-Baltimore County residents.
